Progress Report February 2013

The photographs represent BEFORE and CURRENT photographs showing our progress to date with our Garden Project. We still require another four truck loads of soil and compost along with shade cloth to enclose the shade house and also deer netting to surround the garden plots and to be used for climbing plants and berries that are already planted.

The garden produce is being used by Marae whanau, hapu and iwi, the local Kohanga Reo, hireage users of the Marae, as well as the small local Puketapu community. The gardens need a good tidy up ready for the next plantings.
